

## **SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION SHEET**

### **North Carolina Association of Assessing Officers & North Carolina Tax Collectors Association Scholarship Fund**

#### **SCHOLARSHIP**

1. The scholarship is sponsored by the North Carolina Association of Assessing Officers and the North Carolina Tax Collectors Association.
2. The scholarship shall be for attendance of any recognized, college, university or trade school.
3. The amount of the scholarship is \$1000.00

#### **APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. The applicant shall maintain a grade average consistent with good standing in high school and with expectations of admission to a recognized institution (or, if already attending a recognized institution of higher education with good standing at the institution.)
2. Participation in extracurricular activities (school and community).
3. Good character.
4. The applicant must have been accepted for admission at the institution of choice for the academic year for which the scholarship application is submitted.
5. Submission of completed application to the NCAAO-NCTCA Scholarship Fund Committee, giving complete information as requested, prior to March 25.
6. An applicant must be a child or grandchild of a North Carolina Tax Department employee.

#### **APPLICATION**

1. Data to be submitted with application:
  - **\*\*SSN is requested on application; it is needed ONLY if scholarship awarded\*\***
  - A high school or college transcript, whichever is applicable. (High school transcript should include first semester senior grades, SAT and/or ACT scores, and cumulative numerical academic average.)
  - Name, phone number and address of one personal reference.
  - Name, phone number and address of one faculty reference.
  - A listing of activities and/or honors in school, community and church with one reference with phone number and address for each activity and/or honor.
  - Letter from applicant stating plans, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship.
  - A list of scholarships applied for and scholarships awarded.
